Shareholder Agreement – from £995*

A Shareholder Agreement is an agreement between shareholders of a company to regulate the business relationship between the shareholders and the managers of the company in order, determine the way in which the company is run. Shareholder Agreements are used to protect all parties involved to ensure that a majority cannot use their voting power to the detriment of the other parties.

Articles of Association – from £995*

Articles of Association are written rules which specify a company's operational regulations and the company's overall purpose. These are generally thought of as a company's 'user manual', defining the specific methods to be used to accomplish the company's purpose. The content of the Articles typically includes details on the company's name, directors, share structure and any provisions regarding the shareholders meetings. Articles of Association must be uploaded when you register your company with Companies House.

Partnership Agreement – from £795*

A Partnership Agreement is a document which determines how a business will run under the partnership of two or more people. This agreement will lay out the responsibilities of each partner, for example the percentage division of the company between the partners as well as the partners responsibility for profit and loss margins.

Confidentiality/ Non-Disclosure Agreements – from £795*

A Confidentiality/non-disclosure agreement is an agreement which legally prevents those involved from disclosing confidential information. These are most often used in instances where there is sensitive corporate information which should not be made available to the public or a company's competitors.

Loan Agreement - from £795*

A Loan Agreement is simply the document which a Lender (e.g., bank, building society) will set out the terms and conditions which they are prepared to loan the borrower funds. These may also be referred to as 'facilities agreements'.

Joint Venture Agreement – from £795*

A Joint Venture Agreement is an agreement between two or more parties, who are seeking to co-operate to achieve various commercial objectives.

Terms & Conditions / Terms of Business – from £795*

An Exclusivity Agreement is used to provide a security blanket to ensure that one party of the potential transaction can only negotiate with then for a mutually agreed period of time. This provides security to the counterparty, ensuring that during the timeframe agreed, they cannot be outbid.
